we will have the correct insurances in place for July 2025, ie minimum £5 million public liability insurance (you will need to provide a copy of your insurance certificate)
if a food stall we have a food rating of 4 or 5 (or the equivalent) and hygiene certification
if a food stall and using oil or other products for cooking we will protect the ground with rubber matting or similar to stop oil penetration onto the grass. All damage to the ground must be made good or costs will be charged for repair
we understand that food and drink vendors are encouraged to offer a small discount to volunteer stewards/event staff on duty

if bringing gas cylinders to the event we will store, use and secure correctly
if using gas cylinders or flames we have the relevant fire safety equipment eg extinguishers, fire blankets
we are not bringing gas (or not sure yet)
if bringing a generator to the event our generator is silent (if you attend the event with a generator that is not silent and you subsequently cannot run your stall no refund will be given). (NOTE generators cannot be filled on site). No petrol generators on site under any circumstances
we are not bringing a generator
all electrical equipment brought onto site must have a current PAT certificate or it will not be allowed to connect to the event's electrical supply (if any equipment trips a circuit breaker it must be immediately isolated and left unused, no refunds will be given if equipment cannot be used due to the above, and supplementary charges will be levied to cover any damage caused)
we are not bringing electrical items (or not sure yet)
we are responsible for bringing our own gazebo/marquee and all equipment including any tables & chairs we need
our gazebo will be securely tied and weighted down, with guy ropes and X-bars used if needed on windy days. All potential trip hazards, such as guy ropes, will be clearly marked with flags, tape, or similar materials. If the Event Safety Manager finds that a stall or tent lacks sufficient stability, trading may need to cease, and deposits may be forfeited. To ensure safety, all gazebos and tents should have adequate pegs, ropes, and weights, especially in windy conditions.
$\hfill \square$ we must vacate the venue by 7pm on the Sunday at the end of the event (your pitch must be left in the condition you found it)
if we use more areas than we have booked the event manager will charge for the extra space used (your pitch must include all your trading area, storage etc
if selling alcohol a TENS licence (Temporary Event Notice) will be required from Ashford Borough Council. We understand it is our responsibility to do this and failure to comply will mean we will be unable to sell alcohol at the event
we are not selling alcohol
we must not stop trading before the minimum trading times specified above. Please be aware that no vehicle movements can occur while the event is in progress.

parking is not permitted behind or by your stall unless your vehicle forms part of
your stall
no vehicle movements can occur while the event is in progress
drip trays must be placed under any vehicles that are prone to leaking oil, and no diesel oil or other fuels may be spilled on the grass or other surface
vehicles must not be parked on (or must not obstruct) paths or emergency access routes on the Recreation Ground
all stall rubbish must be REMOVED at the end of each day and not left on site, all food stalls must provide a rubbish bin/bag at the front/side of their stall and take their own rubbish away. If rubbish is dumped in our waste compound or a public bin there we a chargeable fee
we are responsible for the behaviour of everyone working on our stall
knives and sharp utensils must be kept out of reach of the public at all times
spikes and/or pegs must not be driven more than 18 inches vertically into the ground
traders are not permitted to sublet stalls, if you wish to share a stall with someone else you must be upfront about it from the beginning
it is not permitted to give pets/animals away as prizes

### CANCELLATION

If cancelled less than 30 days of the event the charge will be 100% of the pitch price and electrical connection cost. Otherwise the cancellation charge will be 50% of the pitch price only. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event at any time in unforeseen circumstances. You will not be entitled to a refund of any monies paid if you fail to attend the event.

### **PAPERWORK**

The paperwork listed below must be received no later than four weeks before the festival. If we do not receive this you will not be permitted to trade at the festival.

- Detailed list of food/menu/goods to be sold
- If selling food signed allergen form if applicable
- Public, Product and Employers Liability insurance
- Copy of Food Hygiene certificate if applicable
- Copy of Risk Assessment
- Copy of gas testing certificate if applicable
- Copy of TENS notice if applicable

### RUBBISH

- Traders are responsible for catering waste, litter on their pitch and in the small public area directly in front of the pitch. Litter on general site is the responsibility of the festival organisers
- No facilities will be provided for the disposal of cooking oils, hot coals, waste water or stall generated rubbish
- Any trader found using public or festival bins, or leaving food or other waste behind on site will be liable to pay additional charges

### WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

Your application will be assessed, and we will respond to you as soon as possible. Priority will be given to local traders. Due to high demand we will be limiting the number of exhibitors with the same product range. If your application is accepted, you will be sent payment details. Please note, non/late payment or if we are unable to contact you, may result in your application being cancelled and your pitch given to someone else on our waiting list.
